Dear Meadows Residents,

It's time for some yearly maintenance; we will be sweeping the roads and parking stalls and painting parking lines and numbers this up-coming week. The following lets you know about parking. If you are still parked in your stall, (when its your turn to move) they will tow your car. If that happens, (or you have any other questions about this please call Teton HOA Management at 656-8811. Pay special attention to the dates and times. Sweeping will be done in two days, and painting will take three. We are sorry for this necessary inconvenience.

Monday, May 24, 2010: Countryside and the Cross Streets need to park on Sunflower from 8am to 6pm. You will be able to move back to your spots at 6pm.

Tuesday, May 25, 2010: The street sweeper will be cleaning Sunflower, so Sunflower residents move to Countryside, or the cross streets. Starts at 8 am DO NOT move back at 6 pm today move back at 6 pm May 26th.

Wednesday, May 26, 2010: Since Sunflower is already moved they will be painting Sunflower first. Please park in your spots at 6pm today.

Thursday, May 27, 2010: Painting will commence on the Crossroad streets today, so park anywhere but in your spots from 8 am to 6 pm.

Friday, May 28, 2010: Countryside needs to clear out to Sunflower, from 8 am to 6 pm to get your stalls and numbers painted.

Depending on the weather, inclement or otherwise, check for updates in the mail-hut.  
If you do not move on the appropriate days you will be towed.

Park in only marked areas or on the sides. DO NOT park in the grass, common areas, or sidewalks. Park on asphalt only.

A quick reminder: You only have two marked parking spots; if you have a third vehicle you will need to make other arrangements or it will be towed. You cannot park your third vehicle here. You MUST have an orange parking tag with your two cars. All non-marked spots or those labeled with 'V' s are for visitors. Trailers are not allowed in the complex.

Thank you for your time, and patience with this. The parking will look great when it is finished.
