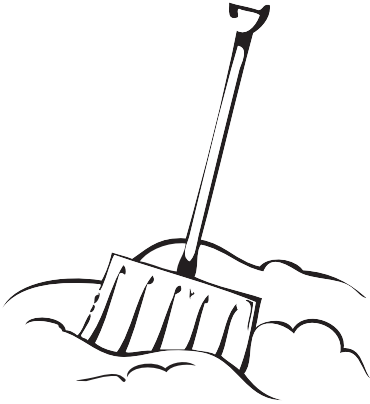


Winter Reminders



SNOW REMOVAL

Be aware that snow removal has a 3-inch minimum before sidewalks are shoveled and the parking lot is plowed. As the HOA pays for the clearing of the main roads and sidewalks, we ask your help keep costs down by removing the snow on your porches, parking spaces and immediate areas. The HOA may have parking cleared during the winter if snow buildup is severe.

New cement (1 year or younger) will be damaged if ice-melt (salt) is used. Please use sand. The salt also kills the grass. **NO SALT PLEASE!**

SNOW PARKING

Please park your vehicle so the front of your car doesn't overhang on the sidewalks so the snow can be plowed easily. See picture. Snow removal will not be responsible for any damages incurred.

DOGS



- You are required to clean up immediately after your dog.
- No unleashed dogs.
- No dogs are allowed to be tied outside of your unit.
- The ONLY place for your dog to do it's business is the west side of Countryside Ave , NOT in common areas, and immediately pick it up.

Residents out of compliance will receive the following action:	1st offense- written or verbal warning
	2nd- \$100 fine
	3rd- \$300 fine
	4th- Pets Banned

If you see someone dumping their tree, please let them know. Rexburg City has a dumping site in Smith Park (they have a big bonfire for Snow Days).

When cleaning up your Christmas gifts please remember the Rexburg City's Garbage Company will only dump a dumpster if there is NO garbage around the can and all boxes are broken down. If a dumpster is full DO NOT put your trash next to the dumpster. Please go to another available dumpster.
